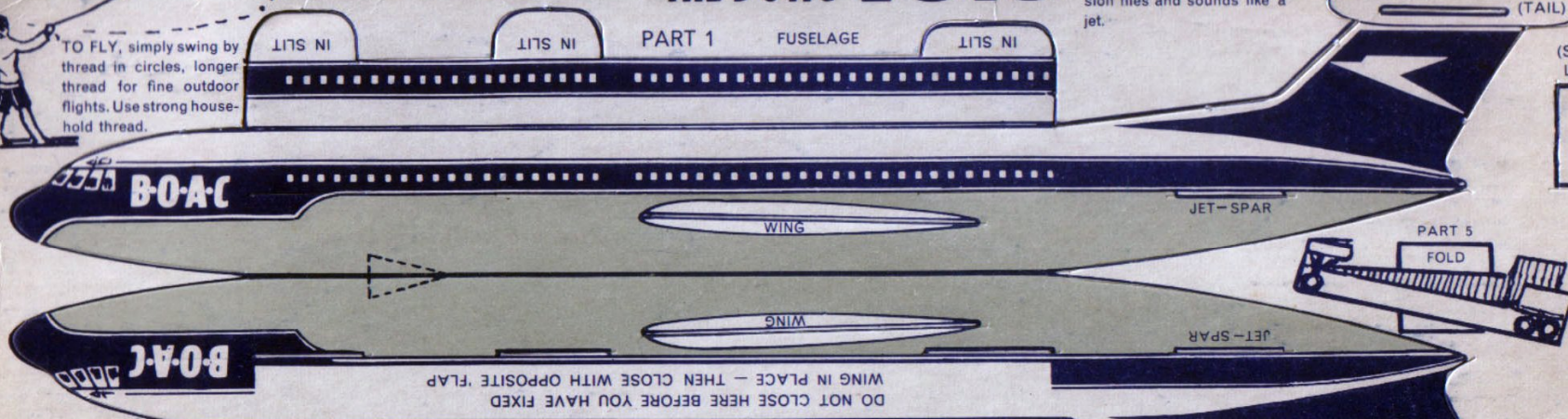


# THE B-O-A-C VC10

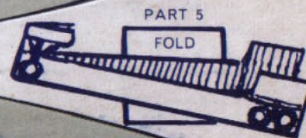
The World's most advanced Jetliner. This miniature version flies and sounds like a jet.



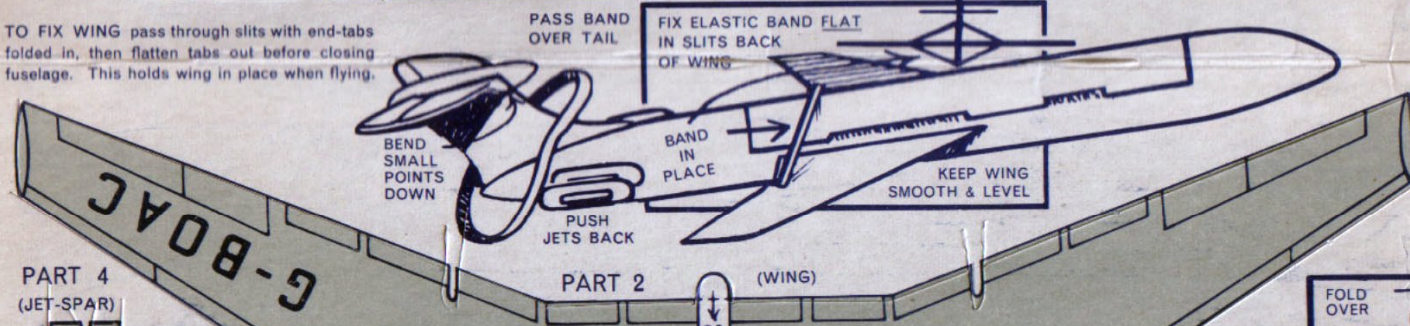
TO FLY, simply swing by thread in circles, longer thread for fine outdoor flights. Use strong household thread.



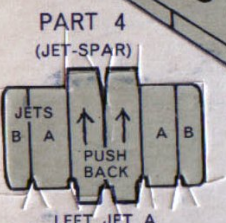
**PART 5**  
(STAND WITH LANDING GEAR)



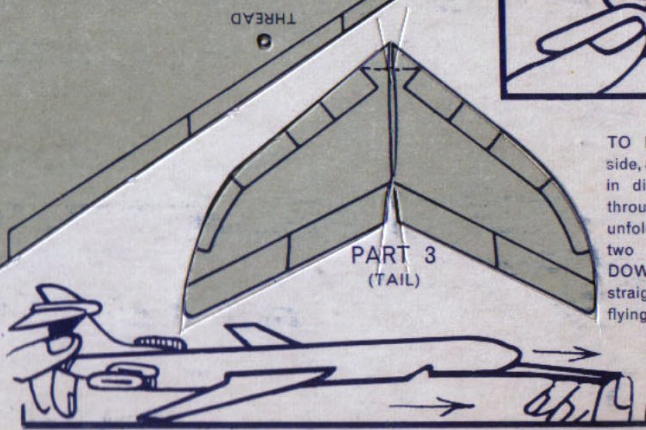
TO FIX WING pass through slits with end-tabs folded in, then flatten tabs out before closing fuselage. This holds wing in place when flying.



TO FIX ELASTIC BAND (for jet sound) pass band carefully over tail-end then gently and carefully stretch it over the fuselage, with its ends in the two small cuts in wing-edge. SEE THAT IT IS FLAT (not twisted) AT ALL TIMES.



TO CATAPULT-LAUNCH, cut with scissors, the small slanting cut (shown under nose), hook elastic band in it, then pull with thumb and finger by other end, holding model by back-fin. DO NOT FLY INTO WALLS etc.



TO FIX TAIL fold one side, at the back, as shown in diagram, pass gently through the tail-slits, then unfold out. Bend those two small front-points DOWN. See that tail is straight and level before flying.
